## KAYAK & SMALL BOAT STORAGE

Storage racks are located at the West End Beach on Donner Lake for Kayaks and other small boats such as one-man outrigger canoes and rowing sculls. Rentals are seasonal only, running from May to September. You can rent for the season at a discount price, or pay monthly. Locks and cables are not provided.



Season: May-September (5 months)  
Rental Fees: \$100 season or \$25/month  
24 slots offered.

## OUTRIGGER CANOEING 101

You could even race with the local canoe club, Kawaiulu O Tahoe in a late summer races! **For ages 16+.** *Participants must be comfortable in the water, and know how to tread water.*

Bring your completed waiver form and payment to the District Office at 8924 Donner Pass Rd. (near the Pioneer Center round-about) Monday through Thursday 8:00 am-5:30 pm or Friday 8:00 am-5:00 pm. Cash, check and Visa or MasterCard are accepted.

### Mail In



Mail your completed registration form and payment to T.D.R.P.D. at: 8924 Donner Pass Rd, Truckee, California 96161. We do not mail confirmations, so you may wish to call the District Office at 530-582-7720 to confirm receipt of your payment.

### Fax In



You may fax your completed waiver form with credit card payment information to the District Office at **530-582-7724**. The fax line is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. **Please call to confirm receipt of your fax during regular business hours.**

## GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

This brochure covers classes offered for the 2010 Spring/Summer. You may register for any class starting May 3rd, unless a specific registration date is listed. Don't wait! Popular classes fill long before the start date. Fees will not be accepted in class unless otherwise noted (Drop ins). *The Instructor or District has the right to cancel classes if they are under enrolled.*

### REGISTRATION CONFIRMATIONS

We do not mail confirmations. If the class you have chosen is changed or cancelled or is full, we will call you. If you do not hear from us, you should attend the class as scheduled or you may call us to confirm.

MATERIALS FEES: Please pay all materials fees directly to the instructor at the first class meeting.

CHECK POLICY: We cannot accept out of state checks, and all checks must have a Driver's License number for the person signing the check. A \$25 fee will be assessed on all returned checks.

TDRPD RESIDENCY INFO: You do NOT have to be a TDRPD resident in order to attend classes, or use our facilities; *however*, you must show proof of residency for discounts on certain facilities and rentals. Proof of residency is required for access to our July 4th West End Beach Celebration. (see inside back cover). *District boundaries are generally the Nevada County portions of the Floriston to Summit Areas*
